Environmental Protections Act (2018)

An act to help mitigate unsightly clutter throughout the natural environment resulting from urban expansion and development.

Article 1 - Regulations

- All residents shall be obligated to fully cut down any trees that they harvest for wood. Anyone caught neglecting this rule is to be punished with a fine amounting to a total value of no less than 5 diamonds. This applies to trees on private property.
- II. Causing excessive and unnecessary destruction on undeveloped wild land under Bloom's jurisdiction shall be considered Minor Griefing in accordance with section 1, paragraph 5 of the Bloom Criminal Code.
- III. Random structures built on undeveloped wild land under Bloom's jurisdiction which depict profane imagery (e.g. penises, swastikas) may be demolished at the government's discretion.

Article 2- Enforcement

I. Federal and local legislators shall reserve the right to pass legislation for the purposes of better enforcing the regulations outlined in this act.
