Construction Administration Act (2018)

An act to assist the government in enforcing dereliction laws within the Capital.

Article 1 - Permissions

- Anyone who wishes to build a structure within the township of the City of Bloom on their private property and wishes to reinforce it under their own private group must add the current Prime Minister to that private group as an admin until construction is completed.
- II. Once construction is completed, the property owner may remove the Prime Minister from the private group at their discretion.

Article 2 - Accountability

I. The Prime Minister may not abuse their permissions to commit theft, griefing, or any other unlawful act. Such action is to be considered abuse of power.
